Most of our members pay their subscriptions through their employer, directly from their wage packet. The monthly cost varies dependant on your wage but is calculated thus:

gross annual salary x 0.6, divided by 100, divided by 12.

As a rough guide:

If you earn £14,000 your monthly subs will be only £7

If you earn £20,000 your monthly subs will still be only £10

The maximum amount is £11.90 a month (likely to apply to Executive Grades only).

If you are employed in the private sector your subscriptions may need to be collected by another means.
